Code of Conduct for Pedicab Drivers

I (name) _____ hereby certify that in the course of my activities as a Pedicab Riders
I will:

Ensure the safety of my passengers, other road users and myself at all times and take all measures to avoid accidents and incidents

Abide by the rules as set out in The Highway Code at all times

At no time be under the influence of alcohol or any drug that might alter my judgment

Ensure that my passengers wear a safety lap belt on all journeys

Charge separate and distinct fares for each specific journey

Ensure that all items belonging to passengers are stowed and that scarves, coats or any other objects are safely contained within the pedicab

Not overload my pedicab i.e. I will only take passengers if they can be seated in my pedicab up to a maximum of three passengers

Be courteous and considerate to other road users, pedestrians, the police and passengers at all times

Not cause an obstruction to other vehicles or pedestrians

Wear my ID tag at all times when driving my pedicab

Carry out prescribed safety checks each time I take out my pedicab

Assist any other pedicab driver (regardless of company) if they are experiencing difficulties or are in danger of assault

Not become involved in racing of any kind

Hand in any lost property to the Operating Company

Take particular care that female passengers arrive at their destination safely. Offer to phone for another pedicab or taxi if you can not complete the journey

Not smoke or use a mobile phone whilst riding

Not ride in pedestrian areas or on the pavement

Not make any action that might damage the reputation of the operator or the industry

Agree the fare with passengers (per person) prior to embarking on a journey & not to demand more

Report and document any accident or incident immediately or within 24 hours to the owner of the pedicab

To keep a record of when you checked in/out of the depot with the operator
